

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the Youth Jam Budget of \$31,999)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 97-234**

**WHEREAS, gang violence, drugs and suicide are claiming ever increasing numbers of our O'odham youth; and**

**WHEREAS, within the last four months, the Tohono O'odham Nation has experienced three teen suicides, two of which were gang related; and**

**WHEREAS, our old tribal building, a historic building, was vandalized and burned by gang members; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation also regularly confronts gang violence, school drop outs and many indictments for drug and alcohol; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation can no longer ignore gang activity among our youth.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation that as a response to the influence that gangs have on Native American Youth, the Tohono O'odham Nation will host a YOUTH JAM, a day specifically for Native American Youth and concerned parents on Saturday, June 21, 1997, all day, at the Baboquivari High School in Sells, Arizona.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that YOUTH JAM will reinforce the notion that our youth belong to something already, their tribal culture**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the YOUTH JAM budget is approved as submitted in the amount of \$31,999, provided that the amount expended under this authority does not at any time exceed the amount appropriated or received from contributions, and that any receipts collected by sponsors, contributions and/or donations be applied to the General Fund.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the funding source will be identified by the Accounting Department.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 18TH. day of JUNE, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,807.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 120.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
