RESOLUTION NO. 97-242

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services provides for the health and welfare needs of O'odham children and families pursuant to a 93-638 Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services prepared a Fiscal Year 1997 budget based on Fiscal Year 1996, BIA Allocations; and

WHEREAS, for Fiscal Year 1997 there is a decrease of \$877,946 from Fiscal Year 1996 allocation; and

WHEREAS, the Department has proposed the attached budget modifications to reflect the final allocations for Fiscal Year 1997.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it hereby approves modification #1 of the Social Services, Children Home Program and Adult Care Group Home budgets based on the following final BIA allocation amounts for Fiscal Year 1997:
