**RESOLUTION NO. 97-254**

**WHEREAS, at a Pisinemo District Council meeting held on June 16, 1997,  
discussion was held with regard to FY-97 Budget  
Modification Requisition #2; and**

**WHEREAS, it was known by all Pisinemo District Council members that  
monies approved for this purpose was being distributed  
from the Pisinemo Community's Line Item #850 - Food.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pisinemo District Council,  
by majority vote, voted in favor of allocating additional  
monies for Line Item #752 - Equipment - Office in the  
amount of \$2,148.33.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the monies allocated for this line item  
would be distributed from Line Item #850 - Food, of the  
Pisinemo Community District's FY97 Budget as shown on the  
attached Budget Modification #2 of the Pisinemo District,  
and that there is sufficient funds available in this Line Item  
to cover this distribution.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative  
Council hereby approves the addition of Line Item #752 -  
Equipment - Office, to the Pisinemo Community District's  
FY-97 Budget so that monies will be available to assist the  
community of Pisinemo.**


