**WHEREAS, the BIA Papago Agency presented to the Tohono O'odham
Legislative Council the projected base amounts for FY 1999;
and**

**WHEREAS, the Papago Agency submitted the Tribal Priority Allocation
programs, consolidated funding and staffing allocation
levels and Decision Ranking Charts to the Tohono O'odham
Legislative Council; and**

**WHEREAS, the priority Decision Ranking Charts provide the Tohono
O'odham Nation the opportunity to participate in the
Federal/Budget formulation process for the allocation and
ranking of resources; and**

**WHEREAS, the priority Decision Ranking Charts, depict the Nation's
priorities as previously established; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed the
proposed Decision Ranking Charts as submitted; and**

**WHEREAS, under the Phoenix Area Office Law Enforcement Program,
an amount of funds exists for training purposes for the
Tohono O'odham Ranger Program.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council that the following Priority Ranking Chart be adopted**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Ranger Program training funds in the Phoenix Area Office Law Enforcement Program be transferred to the Tohono O'odham Nation base amount for the Tribal Priority Allocation program Law Enforcement/Ranger Program.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 26TH. day of JUNE, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,620.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 307.0 NOT VOTING; and [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
