**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has always had a concern for
the health and welfare of its members; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nation received notification of available funding
through I.H.S. for Elder Health Care Initiatives; and**

**WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services/Division of Senior
Services has developed a proposal in response to the
notification; and**

**WHEREAS, the project proposal includes components for the
development of a Home Health Agency, and to provide
educational material promoting prevention of health
problems, for both elders and caregivers; and**

**WHEREAS, there is a need for a coordinated, comprehensive delivery of
basic services to frail and disabled elders living on the
Tohono O'odham Nation.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council that:**

- 1. It hereby approves the submission of the Elder Health
Care Proposal of the Tohono O'odham Human Services
Department/Division of Senior Services.**
