- WHEREAS, the TOHA Board of Commissioners is responsible for providing guidance and direction for the TOHA in order to properly meet the Housing needs of the Nation's members as well as to monitor and regulate the TOHA's Executive Director duties and responsibilities; and
- WHEREAS, the TOHA has been in non-compliance with HUD program and reporting requirements consistently for several years, and has failed to provide new housing for some of the
