RESOLUTION NO. 97-283

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council did approve the FY 1997 Soil & Water Conservation District budget by Council Resolution No. 96-462; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1 of Ordinance No. 02-86, it is the policy of the Tohono O'odham Nation to provide for the conservation and restoration of national lands and soil, moisture and watershed resources, for the control and prevention of floods, soil erosion and sedimentation, the preservation and improvement of soil fertility, and the beneficial use of flood waters and thereby to conserve, protect and enhance the land, vegetation, wildlife and the scenic, recreational and natural resources of the Nation, and in such a manner to promote the public health, safety and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did enact Resolution No. 96-571, approving the Soil and Water Conservation District's Long Range Plan in fulfillment of the requirement of Section 101(b) of Public Law 103-177, the American Indian Agricultural Resource Management Act (25

U.S.C. paragraph 3711(b) for the development and implementation of an agricultural resource management and monitoring plan; and

WHEREAS, the S.W.C.D. program was directed by the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation, to present the Range Management Code to all eleven Districts of the Tohono O'odham Nation, which will require an additional 11 meetings; and

WHEREAS, the Soil and Water Conservation District requires supplemental funds in the amount of \$9,075.00 to provide additional funding for eleven additional meetings by the S.W.C.D Board to present the Range Management Code to the 11 districts; and

WHEREAS, any modifications for funding shall be approved by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council hereby approves the budget modification for supplemental funds for the Soil & Water Conservation District Program and hereby authorizes expenditures in accordance with the approved budget.
