**RESOLUTION NO. 97-313**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Food Distribution Program under an FY 1997 Grant with the United States Department of Agriculture; and**

**WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'odham Nation and its people; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to renew for provisions of services; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved the FY 1998 Food Distribution Program proposal and budget**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does authorize and request the United States Department of Agriculture to renew with the Tohono O'odham Nation for provision of services titled: Food Distribution Program.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant shall be from October 01, 1997 and as long as there is funding for the Food Distribution Program.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate the**

4 conducted and no executed grant has been approved by the  
5 United States Department of Agriculture.

6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that  
7  
8 the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman,  
9 Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby  
10 authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided  
11 however, that any amendments affecting the funding or  
12 funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior  
13 approval by this Council.

15 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
16 Council on the 31ST day of JULY, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum  
17 was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and  
18 [10] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f)  
19 of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted  
20 by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the  
Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March  
6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
