

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Judicial Services (FY 98 - Judicial Services Recontract Proposal))**

RESOLUTION NO. 97-319

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Judicial Services under FY 1997 P.L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'odham Nation and its people; and

WHEREAS, 25 CFR 271.20 of the Code of Federal Regulations requires that all proposals to recontract under P.L. 93-638 be submitted to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the current termination; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to recontract for provision of services during FY 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved the FY 1998 Judicial Services contract proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to recontract with the Tohono O'odham Nation under P.L. 93-638 Regulations and procedures for the provision of services titled: Judicial Services Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this recontract shall commence on October 01, 1997 through September 30, 1998.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that
the Tohono O’odham Nation will not fund or operate the
program in the interim while negotiations are still being
conducted and no executed contract has been approved by the
Bureau of Indian Affairs, unless the agency authorizes and
approves pre-award costs consistent with the Indian Self-
Determination Act, as amended and relevant contract
regulation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Judicial Service proposal is being
submitted in accordance with the terms of the Tohono
O’odham Master Contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that
the Tohono O’odham Nation’s officials to wit: the Chairman
and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate
and execute the contract, provided however, that any
amendment affecting the funding or funding levels of the
contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
Council.
