

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1997 Water Resources Study Program Budget Modification No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 97-326

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3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Water**
4 **Resources Study Program under a P.L. 93-638 Contract with the**
5 **Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**
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7 **WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to**
8 **the Tohono O'odham Nation and its people; and**
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10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has submitted a proposed**
11 **recontract application complete with a budget totaling**
12 **\$1,753,551 to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the continuation**
13 **of the Water Resources Study Program during fiscal year 1997;**
14 **and**
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16 **WHEREAS, the United States has a statutory obligation pursuant to Section**
17 **303(b)(1) of the Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act to**
18 **provide funds for the Water Resources Study Program; and**
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20 **WHEREAS, an amount of \$107,300 has been identified by the Bureau of**
21 **Indian Affairs, Central Office for the FY 1997 contract with the**
22 **Nation; and**

23 **WHEREAS, an additional amount of \$50,000 is allocated for the United**
24 **States Geological Service Cooperative Border Study; and**
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26 **WHEREAS, authorization was requested and granted to enter into a joint**
27 **funding agreement between the U.S. Geological Survey and the**
28 **Water Resources Study Program of the Tohono O'odham Nation**

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(Water Resources Study Program Budget Modification No. 1)

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to conduct a hydrologic investigation along a portion of the southern boundary of the Nation and \$50,000 is to fund this cooperative agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Water Resource Study Program does submit for review and approval of Budget Modification No. 1 reflecting the amount of \$184,041; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved the FY 1997 Water Resources Study Program contract proposal and budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that:

- 1. The Tohono O’odham Legislative Council does authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to renew with the Tohono O’odham Nation under P.L. 93-638 as amended the provision of service titled: Water Resources Study Program.**
- 2. The duration of this contract will commence on October 01, 1996 through September 30, 1997.**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O’odham Nation’s officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, provided

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however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 5TH day of AUGUST, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
