**RESOLUTION NO. 97-329**

**WHEREAS, Indian Health Service, Office of Environmental Health and Engineering (OEH&E) conducts an assessment of Sanitation Facilities Deficiencies, annually; and**

**WHEREAS, the Office of Environmental Health and Engineering assessment does have an impact upon congressional appropriations and IHS allocation of funds; and**

**WHEREAS, Indian Health Services has provided for Tribal Priority ranking of the four (4) most critical projects and does allocate points impacting upon overall prioritization of projects; and**

**WHEREAS, the Office of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided recommendations to the Tohono O'odham Nation regarding the most critical needs.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation has reviewed and approved the entire priority list and has determined that the following deficiencies are the four most critical and desirable, in descending order or prioritization:**


- 1. New Fields Water**
- 2. Queens Well Water**
- 3. Fresnal Village Water**
- 4. Choulic Water**
