- WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is aware of the NAHASDA Legislation and has concerns regarding the impact it will have on Indian Country; and
- WHEREAS, the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination

 Act places Section 8 under Indian Housing; and
- WHEREAS, the Congressional Budget calls for approximately \$35 billion in new budget authority for Section 8 contract renewals; and
- WHEREAS, the appropriations for NAHASDA calls for approximately \$485 million to meet all of the critical needs of Indian Housing by Tribes or Tribally Designated Housing Entities; and
- WHEREAS, it would be more feasible and cost effective to remove Section 8

 from the Native American Housing Assistance and SelfDetermination Act and place it under Public Housing; and
- WHEREAS, the Public Housing \$35 Billion budget could create a component within Public Housing to appropriately address and meet the critical needs of Section 8, Rental Assistance in Indian Programs.
