4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recognizes the need**
5 **to maintain a competitive salary and position classification for**
6 **its judges in order to facilitate the highest level of judicial**
7 **service delivery to the members of the Tohono O'odham**
8 **Nation; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the last salary schedule for judges was approved by the**
11 **Legislative Council in Resolution No. 247-86 on April 22, 1986,**
12 **approximately eleven years ago; and**

14 **WHEREAS, since passage of the last salary schedule, significant changes**
15 **have occurred in the judicial labor market which have not**
16 **been reflected in the salaries of the Tohono O'odham Judges;**
17 **and**

19 **WHEREAS, there is a legitimate interest in attracting judicial talent with**
20 **law degrees as well as properly compensating all judges in**
21 **accordance with their experience, education, powers, duties,**
22 **and productivity; and**

24 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
25 **Council has proposed a schedule for compensation for the**
26 **Judges, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by**
27 **reference; and**

2 **WHEREAS, the Council concurs with the Judiciary Committee's**
3 **recommendation concerning the proposed compensation**
4 **based upon the experience, education, duties and productivity**
5 **of the Judges, and the pay out of appropriate sums to the Judges**
6 **and Court Administrator for accumulate leave time.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
9 **Council that it does hereby approve and adopt the attached**
10 **schedule of compensation proposed by the Judiciary**
11 **Committee for the Judges of the Tohono O'odham Courts,**
12 **effective October 01, 1997.**

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attached schedule of compensation**
15 **supercedes the all former judge's salary schedules and**
16 **modifications including the schedule approved and adopted in**
17 **Resolution No. 247-86, and that Resolution 247-86 is hereby**
18 **rescinded.**

22 **8TH. day of SEPTEMBER, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present**
23 **with a vote of 1,798.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 129.0 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT,**
24 **pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI**
25 **of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
27 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant**
28 **to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
