

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY 1997 Budget Modification #1 for the Individuals with
Disabilities Education Act [IDEA] Part B Contract Number
1450CTH54T61071)**

RESOLUTION NO. 97-360

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has consistently supported the
nurturance of its young members by providing for their
welfare through various programs and services and is desirous
of meeting the special needs of its children with disabilities;
and**

**WHEREAS, the Early Childhood Head Start Program operates throughout
the Tohono O'odham Nation and serves children three to five
years of age who exhibit typical development and children with
disabilities; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has funds through the Bureau of
Indian Affairs pursuant to Public Law 102-119, the Individuals
with Disabilities Education Act as amended to support child
find efforts, screening, parent training and direct service; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Early Childhood Head Start Program has
submitted for review and approval the proposed budget
modification to include cost of purchase of equipment for
conducting screening and the direct service of an occupational
therapist totaling \$5,217 with a corresponding decrease in
salary for a position which is vacant and indirect costs in the
amount of \$5,217.**

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the Tohono O'odham Early Childhood Head Start Program's request for budget modification #1 to the FY 1997 IDEA Part B budget.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 9TH. day of SEPTEMBER, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
