the fields of recreation, education, and cultural experience;  
and**

the Tohono O'odham Nation, Districts, and community  
members, in the provision of these services.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
Council does hereby give its full support for the purpose, goals,  
and efforts of the Tohono O'odham Youth Services.**
