**WHEREAS, Legislative Council Resolution No. 94-264, "Astigmatism and Amblyopia Prevention Project", was passed and enacted; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and endorses the Nation's participation in the Astigmatism and Amblyopia Prevention Project; and**

**WHEREAS, a manuscript entitled, "*Advances in Prevention of Amblyopia Among Native American Children*" was written by Joseph M. Miller, M.D., Associate Professor, University of Arizona Department of Ophthalmology; and**

**WHEREAS, also written is a statement from the University of Arizona Health Science Center entitled, "*UA Department of Ophthalmology Study Test Instruments to Help Prevent Vision Problems in Young Native Americans*"; and**

**WHEREAS, final approval for press release of the articles is recommended.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, pursuant to Resolution No. 94-264 further approves to release information on the Astigmatism and Amblyopia Project, with consultation with the Health and Human Services Committee prior to release to the press.**
