

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Accounting Department Budget Modification #2 and Base

**RESOLUTION NO. 97-382**

**WHEREAS, the Accounting Department of the Executive Branch (the Department) has identified additional staff, operational, and capital requirements; and**

**WHEREAS, sufficient budget savings in salaries and training exists to fund these additional requirements in FY 1997; and**

**WHEREAS, these staff requirements include account technicians and an Audit Resolution Manager; and**

**WHEREAS, the Audit Resolution Manager would provide the Nation with a resource with which it can respond to annual audit findings in the most effective manner; and**

**WHEREAS, the account technicians will assist the Department in responding to the increased workload confronting the department; and**

**WHEREAS, the Department requests that the position of Audit Resolution Manager and that of the account technicians be made permanent and that the base budget of the Department be adjusted accordingly.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve of the Accounting Department's budget modification number two as submitted.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the position of Audit Resolution Manager and account technicians be established as permanent positions of the Accounting Department.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Base Budget of the Department is to be adjusted accordingly to include the full annualized of the approved positions.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 12TH. day of SEPTEMBER, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,781.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 146.0 [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
