

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Adoption of the Scholarship Fund and Nursing Home Fiscal Year 1998  
Budgets and Appropriating Funds from their Respective Reserves)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 97-394**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has by previous legislation provided for reserves to fund the necessary planning of the Nursing Home Project and administration of the Nation's Scholarship Fund; and**

**WHEREAS, the Executive Branch has prepared and presented the FY98 Budgets for both Nursing Home \$3,183,717.87 and the Scholarship Fund, \$6,705,909.11 to continue activities of both programs; and**

**WHEREAS, sufficient funds remain in the established reserves to fund the budgets as presented.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Fiscal Year 1998 budgets of the Scholarship Fund, in the amount of \$6,705,909.11, and the Nursing Home, in the amount of \$3,183,717.87, are hereby adopted and are authorized to be expended accordingly.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amount required by budgets of the Scholarship Fund (\$6,705,909.11) and the Nursing Home (\$3,183,717.87) shall be appropriated from the established reserves.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the fiscal year for the approved budgets shall be from October 01, 1997 and expiring on September 30, 1998.**


