NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Fiscal Year 1998 budgets of the Scholarship Fund, in the amount of \$6,705,909.11, and the Nursing Home, in the amount of \$3,183,717.87, are hereby adopted and are authorized to be expended accordingly.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amount required by budgets of the Scholarship Fund (\$6,705,909.11) and the Nursing Home (\$3,183,717.87) shall be appropriated from the established reserves.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the fiscal year for the approved budgets shall be from October 01, 1997 and expiring on September 30, 1998.
