**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Tohono  
O'odham Psychological Services Treatment Program for the  
Seriously Mentally Ill Tas Tonlik Ki Day Program through a  
P.L. 93-638 grant; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council has approved  
an FY98 SMI budget for \$200,000.00 which does not cover all  
staff positions; and**

**WHEREAS, FY1998 begins September 01, 1997 and the program needs all  
staff positions. The modification has been prepared to cover  
the program for six (6) months.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

- 1. That the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby  
approves the attached FY 1998 Psychological Services -  
SMI Day Program Tas Tonlik Ki Day Program Budget  
Modification #1.**
- 2. That the Tohono O'odham Nation's Official, to wit: the  
Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated Officer  
are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the  
proposal.**
