RESOLUTION NO. 97-401

WHEREAS, the United States Government has increased the federal minimum wage from \$4.75 per hour to \$5.15 per hour to begin on September 1, 1997 with certain limitations for employees under 20 years of age, students, apprentices, and workers with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the need to increase the minimum wage to \$5.15 per hour for all affected employees to begin September 1, 1997.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the increase in the minimum wage to \$5.15 per hour effective September 1, 1997

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 18TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
