

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adoption of the Tohono O'odham Law Enforcement Department's
Fiscal Year 1998 Budget; Appropriating Gaming Revenues and
Authorizing the Carry Over of Unexpended Funds Appropriated for
Fiscal Year 1997)**

RESOLUTION NO. 97-419

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) has by previous legislation appropriated revenues from the Nation's gaming activities to supplement the Nation's Law Enforcement Department (Department) operations; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Branch has prepared and presented the Department's FY 98 Budget in the amount of \$4,563,995.98; and

WHEREAS, the Accounting Department estimates that \$1,510,000.00 of the total amount authorized and appropriated for fiscal year 1997 will remain unspent; and

WHEREAS, it has been the policy of the Nation to permit a reauthorization of unexpended balance of the Department's budget appropriation for the subsequent fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Fiscal Year 1998 budget of the Tohono O'odham Law Enforcement Department is hereby adopted as presented, and are authorized to be expended accordingly.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the total amount required by budgets, \$4,563,995.98 shall be funded as follows:

- 1. \$1,510,000.00 an amount estimated by the Accounting Department to remain unexpended for fiscal year 1997, is**

hereby authorized to be reappropriated for fiscal year
1998.

2. The remaining budget requirement, \$3,053,995.98 is hereby authorized and appropriated from the Nation's gaming revenues received during fiscal year before any other distribution is made to the Nation's districts and/or other funding requirements.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Nation and the Chief Financial Officer, or their designated representatives, are hereby authorized to withdraw and transfer such funds as may be necessary for the expenditures of the Department as provided in the attached budgets.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 29TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,064.0 FOR; 527.0 AGAINST; 190.0 NOT VOTING; and 146.0 [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
