**RESOLUTION NO. 97-422**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the FY 1997 contracts with Bureau of Indian Affairs under a three (3) year Master Contract effective 1 October 1996 through 30 September 1999; and**

**WHEREAS, such Tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to continue services as provided for in Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 97-331 which approved the Annual Funding Agreement (AFA) for FY 1998 for said programs:**

- b) Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)**
- c) Higher Education (Scholarships)**
- d) Johnson O'Malley**
- e) Law Enforcement**
- f) Judicial Services**



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


