WHEREAS, Resolution No. 96-387 required the Executive Branch to conduct a fraud audit and such audit was conducted and the results were reported to the Legislative Council; and

WHEREAS, as a result of these findings of the fraud audit, Resolution No.
96-511 authorized the submission of this matter to the United
States Attorney and the Federal Bureau of Investigations and
these agencies are in the process of conducting a criminal
investigation; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 97-101 provided (1) the Executive Branch additional time to develop and implement management systems (such as, but not limited to, financial management, personnel policies, purchasing regulations, accounting system development, inventory control) which will correct the systemic deficiencies noted in the preliminary audit, (2) propose amendments to the TOFA Plan of Operation for consideration by the Legislative Council; and (3) assess candidates and present
