2 3 WHEREAS, the Nation appropriated operating funds for the Solid Waste 4 Management Program on April 12, 1997, appropriated capital 5 funds for equipment purchases and building construction on 6 July 11, 1997, hired a Solid Waste Program Manager on July 11, 7 1997, and began operation of the Solid Waste Management 8 Program in July 1997; and 9 WHEREAS, the Nation's Solid Waste Management Program has begun to 10 implement the alternative waste hauling system and has ordered 11 12 the trash compactor trucks and the community bins and other 13 equipment, but despite the Program's best efforts the system will 14 not be in place by the October 9, 1997 deadline; and 15 WHEREAS, the implementation of the alternative waste collection and 16 hauling system is expected to begin in early February 1998; and 17 WHEREAS, the dumping and burning prohibitions and the open dump 18 19 closure requirements in the Solid Waste Management Code 20 cannot be enforced until the alternative waste collection and 21 hauling system is in place; and 22 WHEREAS, an extension of time of six (6) months until April 9, 1998 is needed 23
