

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Continuation of Chukut Kuk District Ranger Program)**

**DEFEATED  
RESOLUTION NO. 97-453**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved  
continuation of the Chukut Kuk Ranger Program; and**

**WHEREAS, Chukut Kuk District officials met with Executive, Budget and  
Finance, Law Enforcement, Gu Vo and Pisinemo Districts on  
September 30, 1997 where plans to propose a Nation's Ranger  
program was discussed; and**

**WHEREAS, Chukut Kuk District is requesting an extension of the  
authorized continuation of the Ranger Program until Chukut  
Kuk District Council has been informed about the proposed  
plan and direction given to the officials; and**

**WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds in the FY 97 budget to continue the  
Ranger Program.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chukut Kuk District is  
requesting an extension of the continuation until the  
November Legislative Council Session.**

**The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
Council on the 10TH, day of OCTOBER, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum  
was present, and by a vote of 331.5 FOR; 1,522.5 AGAINST; 73.0 NOT VOTING;  
and [02] ABSENT, failed to pass because it did not receive a majority of the  
votes cast as required by Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution of the  
Tohono O'odham Nation.**
