**RESOLUTION NO. 97-466**

**WHEREAS, cattle ranching is a major enterprise on the Tohono O'odham  
Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, Chutum Vaya Range and Livestock Association of Baboquivari  
District is an active participant in that enterprise; and**

**WHEREAS, the association recognizes a need for supplements with which  
cattle can better utilize range land; and**

**WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District Council supported the Chutum Vaya  
Range and Livestock Association by Resolution No. 97-B-51.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
Council hereby approves the allocation of \$18,840.81 from the  
Baboquivari District Economic Development Account, for the  
purpose identified in Baboquivari District resolution 97-B-51  
(budget consists of two line items (Materials @ \$1,000 and  
Animal Supplies @\$17,840.81).**


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that sufficient funds, in the amount of \$18,840.81,  
is available to be transferred into a separate District account,  
for the Chutum Vaya Range Project, established for  
Baboquivari District by the Tohono O'odham Nation's  
Accounting Department.**
