20		the Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA"), have been involved in

23		monitoring, reclamation standards, a federal mine plan of

25	WHEREAS,	these negotiations have included preparation of an IGA				
26		between the BLM, the BIA, and the Arizona Department of				
27		Environmental Quality ("ADEQ"), for the purpose of providing

11 12 13	to protect the Nation's trust resources; and WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council has reviewed and endorsed the IGA, as evidenced by district resolution No. SXDC 11-97-01
14 15 16	attached hereto; and WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee of the Legislative Council
17 18	has reviewed this final draft of the IGA and recommends its endorsement by the Legislative Council.
19 20 21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation endorses the final draft of the IGA in
22 23	the form attached hereto. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this IGA shall not extend ADEQ or other state
24 25 26	regulatory authority to the San Xavier Reservation nor limit the Nation's or the District's regulatory authority within their territorial jurisdiction.
