1 2 RESOLUTION NO. 97-475 3 WHEREAS, the acquisition of additional equipment is necessary to provide 4 5 adequate fire protection services to the members of the Tohono 6 O'odham Nation; and 7 WHEREAS. by Resolution 97-038, the Legislative Council authorized the 8 Chairman of the Nation, the Chairpersons of the Commerce and 9 **Budget & Finance Committees, the Attorney General and the** 10 Chief of the Fire Department (the "Negotiating Team") to 11 12 negotiate contracts to acquire the fire equipment; and 13 WHEREAS, proposals to supply the equipment have been received from 14 several vendors; and 15 WHEREAS. the Negotiating Team has conducted preliminary discussions 16 regarding bids submitted by two vendors identified by the Chief 17 of the Fire Department as superior based on price, equipment 18 19 reliability and quality of service; and 20 WHEREAS. the Commerce. Budget & Finance and Investment Committees 21 recommend that the Legislative Council set aside funds to 22 acquire the fire equipment, subject to the approval by Council 23 of the purchase contracts upon completion of the negotiations. 24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: 25 26

1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby sets aside the sum of \$1.8 million for the acquisition of the fire

The Investment Committee is authorized and directed to 7 issue appropriate instructions to Bank of America Arizona 8 to establish the set-aside account. 9 3.
