

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorization for Colonia Designation Within the Tohono O'odham Nation)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 97-483**

**WHEREAS, a "Colonia" development as defined by the United States Department of Agriculture has occurred on the Tohono O'odham Nation, located in Pima County; and**

**WHEREAS, unincorporated communities within the County which lack potable water supplies, adequate sewage systems, and/or decent, safe and sanitary housing are eligible for designation as Colonias; and**

**WHEREAS, designation as a Colonia is necessary before certain State and Federal funds can be made available to improve infrastructure systems and housing within those communities; and**

**WHEREAS, all of the communities existed as Colonias before October 1, 1989.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the following communities within the Tohono O'odham Nation, located in Pima County to hereby be designated as colonias because of their lack of adequate potable water supplies, adequate sewage systems, and/or decent safe, and sanitary housing:**

**Baboquivari - Fresnal Canyon, Artesia, Topawa Community, Little Tucson, South Komelic, Cold Fields, Choulic.**

**Chukut Kuk - Ston Shudag, Toro's Ranch, Onion Stand, Tecolote, Serapo's Gate, Itak, Vamori, San Miguel, Hashan Chuchg, New Fields, Buenos Aires, Williams Ranch.**

**GuAchi - Santa Rosa, San Luis, Palo Verde Stand, Ak Chin, Maishp Vaya, Covered Wells, Mountain Village, Sikul Himatk, Chot Vaya, Cababi.**
