

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving a Grant Application to United States Fish and Wildlife Service,
Ratifying the Signature of Joseph T. Joaquin, and Authorizing Expenditure
of Funds from the Grant in Accordance with the Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 97-485

**WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee of the Tohono O'odham
Legislative Council submitted a grant application on behalf of the
Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) to the United States Fish and
Wildlife Service (USFWS) dated 18 September 1995 for a grant in
the amount of \$14,985.50 for a proposal entitled "TRAINING OF
O'ODHAM ON THE PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT OF NATURAL
RESOURCES IN PROTECTED AREAS UTILIZING TRADITIONAL
KNOWLEDGE AND MODERN MANAGEMENT TECHNIQUES;" and**

**WHEREAS, the proposal is to implement a training program for the O'odham
communities in Sonora, Mexico, based on O'odham traditional
knowledge of the environment and the sustainable use of natural
and cultural resources, so that they will fully participate in the
management of the Pinacate and Gran Desierto del Altar
Biosphere Reserves; and**

**WHEREAS, the USFWS entered into a Grant Agreement with the Nation on
September 24, 1996, which was signed on behalf of the Nation by
Joseph T. Joaquin, Chairman of the Cultural Preservation
Committee, as an agent of the Nation, but was not signed by
Edward D. Manuel, Chairman of the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the USFWS submitted a check in the amount of \$14,985.50 to the
Nation on December 20, 1996; and**

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WHEREAS, the grant application and the proposed budget were not previously presented to the Legislative Council for review and approval; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee, Budget & Finance Committee, Executive Review Committee, and Grants & Contracts have approved the grant application and proposed budget as attached hereto, and recommends approval by the Legislative Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation approves the grant application to the USFWS, ratifies the signature of Joseph T. Joaquin on the Grant Agreement, approves the receipt of the funds from the USFWS in the amount of \$14,985.50, authorizes the expenditure of the funds in accordance with the budget presented to the Legislative Council, and authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to sign any additional documents necessary to implement this grant.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 2ND. day of DECEMBER, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,846.5 OR; -0- AGAINST; 80.5 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(8), 1(d)(2) & 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


