WHEREAS,	pursuant to the Gila Bend Indian Reservation Lands Replacement
	Act, P.L. 99-503 (the "Act"), the Tohono O'odham Nation (the
	"Nation") acquired the San Lucy Farm (the "Farm") in May 1988 as
	part of the replacement lands for lands rendered unusable
	through repeated flooding caused by the United States'
	construction of the Painted Rock Dam downstream on the Gila
	River from the Gila Bend Indian Reservation; and

- WHEREAS, the Farm is within the Central Arizona Irrigation & Drainage
 District ("CAIDD"); and
- WHEREAS, the Farm and non-Indian agricultural operations are served by a distribution system (the "Distribution System") which delivers water from the Central Arizona Project for irrigation of crops; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to the Colorado River Basin Project Act, 43 U.S.C. § 1501

 et seq. (the "Basin Project Act"), the United States advanced

 certain costs for the construction of the Distribution System (the

 "Construction Costs") which are subject to repayment by CAIDD;

 and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 401 of the Basin Project Act, 43 U.S.C. § 1541, the Secretary of the Interior (the "Secretary") is required to allocate the Construction Costs between the Farm and non-Indian lands within CAIDD's boundaries; and
- WHEREAS, the Farm's proportionate share of the Construction Costs is approximately \$3 million; and

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3	WHEREAS,	the Farm's repayment obligation of its share of the Construction
4		Costs is secured by a lien on the Farm's lands; and
5	WHEREAS,	the Act requires that the $\operatorname{Secretary}$ take the Farm lands into trust;
6		and
7	WHEREAS,	the Secretary has refused to take the Farm lands into trust until
8		the lien is removed or the Nation enters into an agreement to
9		repay the Farm's share of Construction Costs; and
10	WHEREAS,	depending on the outcome of a study on the repayment capacity
11 12		of the Farm lands, the Nation's repayment obligation must either
13		be cancelled or deferred until the Farm lands are sold by the
14		Nation, in accordance with the provisions of Section 402 of the
15		Basin Project Act, 43 U.S.C. § 1542, and the Leavitt Act, 25 U.S.C.
16		§ 386a; and
17	WHEREAS,	representatives of the United States, the Nation, the San Lucy
18		District and CAIDD have negotiated (1) an Agreement Regarding
19		the Allocation of Construction Costs (the "Cost Allocation
20		Agreement") and (2) an Agreement for District Water Service (the
21		"Water Service Agreement"), copies of which are attached hereto;

23	WHEREAS	the Cost Allocation Agreement allocates the Construction Costs

7		be terminated and replaced by the Water Service Agreement
8		which will govern the terms of water delivery to the Farm and
9		related matters, taking into account the trust status of the Farm

12	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Committee, Agriculture Committee, Natural
13		Resources Committee and the San Lucy District recommend
14		approval by the Legislative Council of the Cost Allocation
15		Agreement and the Water Service Agreement.
