

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Equal Employment Opportunity Commission FY-1998 Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 97-505

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Tribal Employment Rights Office since 1978 and has successfully met the needs of the Tohono O'odham; and

WHEREAS, the funding for the Tohono O'odham Nation Tribal Employment Rights Office has been supplemented by the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission; and

WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Tribal Employment Rights Office is essential to eradicate employment discrimination within the exterior boundaries of the Tohono O'odham Nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that it hereby approves the continued supplemental funding for the Tribal Employment Rights Office from the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant shall commence on October 01, 1997 through September 30, 1998.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5TH day of DECEMBER, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 OR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


