RESOLUTION NO. 97-507

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 96-499, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council approved the expenditure of funds under FEMA Cooperative Agreement EMF-96-GR-0073, for the purpose of training the Nation's SARA Title III Workgroup; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 97-166, the Legislative Council approved a budget modification to this program which allowed for expenditures such as Per Diem, Travel, and Mileage expenses to be paid out of this grant for SARA Title III Workgroup members; and

WHEREAS, the goals of the SARA Title III workgroup had not yet been achieved and there were still grant funds available at the time of the original May 30, 1997 termination date of this grant; and

WHEREAS, a no-cost extension request for this grant was approved by FEMA that extended the period of this grant until December 30, 1997; and

WHEREAS, the SARA Title III Workgroup has recommended that the remaining funds be allocated to materials necessary to the public review process, and a budget modification has been prepared to carry out this recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the extension for FEMA Cooperative Agreement EMF-96-GR-0073, and authorizes expenditures of funds


