

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 98 Ranger Budget and P.L. 93-638 Federal Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 97-511

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation with a land base of 2.8 million acres and a population of 19,255 members contracts its own Law Enforcement Program and Ranger Program under PL 93-638; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council acknowledges the need to continue the Ranger Program and Law Enforcement Program under the P.L. 93-638 contract; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council has reviewed and supports the attached Ranger Program budget under Law Enforcement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council authorizes Grants & Contracts to de-obligate and transfer \$459,600 (operations) from FY 1996 held in P.L. 93-638 and re-obligate \$459,600 (operations) to FY 1998; to de-obligate and transfer \$50,100 (training) from FY 1996 held in P.L. 93-638 and re-obligate \$50,100 (training) to FY 1998; to de-obligate and transfer \$111,205 (operations) from FY 1997 held in P.L. 93-638 and re-obligate \$111,205 (operations) to FY 1998.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation authorizes the de-obligation and re-obligation of funds held in P.L. 93-638 for FY 1996 and 1997 to FY 1998.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation also authorizes the appropriation of funds held in P.L. 93-
