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Regulatory Act. 25 U.S.C. § 2710 (b) (3): (2) acceptance by the Legislative Council of a Certification of Eligible Members submitted by the Enrollment Office and based upon receipt of a properly completed and filed Certificate of Eligibility Verification for Per Capita Payment for each member; and (3) as to each Minor Eligible Member, establishment of a restricted account at Bank of America for deposit of such member's per capita payment; and WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 97-452, the Legislative Council adopted a Revenue Allocation Plan and caused the Plan to be submitted for approval by the Phoenix Area Office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs in accordance with authority delegated to the Area Office by the Secretary of the Interior; and WHEREAS, by letter dated December 18, 1997 (a copy of which is attached). the Area Office approved the Revenue Allocation Plan with respect to the Initial Per Capita Distribution and disapproved the Plan with respect to the Biennial Per Capita Payments: and WHEREAS, Bank of America has not yet presented its proposal for the establishment of the restricted accounts which are required as a condition to disbursement of the Initial Per Capita Distribution to such accounts for Minor Eligible Members, but has expressed an intention to submit such proposal in January 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Enrollment Office has filed with the Legislative Council a

Certification of Eligible Members listing 11,233 adult members

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who are eligible for receipt of the Initial Per Capita Distribution; and

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WHEREAS, all conditions under the laws of the United States and the Nation have been satisfied to permit the disbursement of the Initial Per Capita Distribution to the members listed in the Certification of Eligible Members.
