

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adopting the Tohono O'odham Solid Waste Management
Program Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-002

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation"), in exercise of its sovereign authority, desires to manage and regulate the storage, collection, recycling, transportation and disposal of solid waste and certain hazardous waste on lands within the boundaries of the Nation in order to protect the Nation's environment, its natural resources, the political integrity and economic security of the Nation, and the health, safety and welfare of its members and all persons present on the lands of the Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council ("Legislative Council") adopted the Solid Waste Management Code and Solid Waste Management Plan on February 12, 1997 and amended the Solid Waste Management Code on October 16, 1997; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council approved the budget for the Solid Waste Management Program on April 17, 1997 with Resolution No. 97-138 and July 17, 1997 with Resolution No. 97-279, and has approved the FY-98 base budget of \$164,145.72; and

WHEREAS, the adopted Solid Waste Management Plan has the Nation implementing a program that will provide solid waste collection for all villages by way of bins placed in each community and a trucking system to collect the solid waste from the bins and haul the waste to landfills located off of the Nation's lands; and

WHEREAS, the Nation will pay for 100% of the capital costs and approximately 50% of the operating costs, and residents, businesses and agencies will pay for approximately 50% of the operating costs; and

WHEREAS, the Human Resources Department has hired a solid waste manager to implement the solid waste management program; and

WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District has approved the use of five acres approximately one half mile from Highway 86 on the Sikul Himath Road in District Resolution No. 1297-164 for the Solid Waste Office, Recycling Maintenance Building and Equipment Storage Yard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the carry-over funds appropriated in 1997 for capital, personnel and operating costs of \$482,989.22; transfer of personnel funds from Well Maintenance Program to Solid Waste Management Program of \$65,518.56; and the appropriation of supplemental funds of \$127,450.00 from the General Revenue Account; and those funds that are marked recurring will be incorporated on an annualized basis into fiscal year 1999's base budget as detailed in the attached information.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5TH day of JANUARY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
