1 2 RESOLUTION NO. 98-002 3 4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation"), in exercise of its sovereign 5 authority, desires to manage and regulate the storage, collection, 6 recycling, transportation and disposal of solid waste and certain 7 hazardous waste on lands within the boundaries of the Nation in 8 order to protect the Nation's environment, its natural resources. 9 the political integrity and economic security of the Nation, and the 10 11 health, safety and welfare of its members and all persons present 12 on the lands of the Nation; and 13 WHEREAS. the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council ("Legislative Council") 14 adopted the Solid Waste Management Code and Solid Waste 15 Management Plan on February 12, 1997 and amended the Solid 16 Waste Management Code on October 16, 1997; and 17 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council approved the budget for the Solid Waste 18 19 Management Program on April 17, 1997 with Resolution No. 97-138 20 and July 17, 1997 with Resolution No. 97-279, and has approved the  $\mathbf{21}$ FY-98 base budget of \$164,145.72; and 22 WHEREAS, the adopted Solid Waste Management Plan has the Nation **23** implementing a program that will provide solid waste collection 24 for all villages by way of bins placed in each community and a 25 trucking system to collect the solid waste from the bins and haul 26 the waste to landfills located off of the Nation's lands; and 27
