RESOLUTION NO. 98-004

**WHEREAS, Safe Ride, Inc. a private company which specializes in the
provision of transportation services for dialysis and non-
emergency medically necessary transportation on the Tohono
O'odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 91-377
permitting Safe Ride, Inc. to provide Transportation Services on
the Tohono O'odham Nation has expired and there is no renewal
of agreement in effect; and**

**WHEREAS, presently, Safe Ride, Inc. continues to provide dialysis and non-
emergency transportation services on the Tohono O'odham
Nation and continues to seek reimbursement from the Arizona
Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS) with no liability
to the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nation is desirous of utilizing transportation services by Safe
Ride, Inc.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council does hereby approve to authorize and grant permission
for Safe Ride, Inc. to continue operating transportation services.**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:

- 1. Safe Ride, Inc. shall abide by the Tribal Employment Rights
Ordinance (TERO) and other ordinance by the Nation as they
apply to transportation services and employment operating on
the reservation.**

Safe Ride, Inc. Transportation Services on the Tohono O'odham Nation will be exclusively authorized and permitted for ninety (90) days unless an agreement is renewed to continue services.

3. Safe Ride, Inc. will work and communicate with other entities (Indian Health Services, Nation's Districts, Private Companies, Tribal Governments Branches, i.e. Executive, Legislative and Judicial and most of all, our O'odham).

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7TH day of JANUARY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,856.0 FOR; 71.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(2) and Section 2(d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
