NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve to authorize and grant permission for Safe Ride, Inc. to continue operating transportation services. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:

> 1. Safe Ride, Inc. shall abide by the Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance (TERO) and other ordinance by the Nation as they apply to transportation services and employment operating on the reservation.
