

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting the submittal of the Tohono O'odham Nation Welfare-To-Work
Plan for Fiscal Year 1998)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-014

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has received planning guidance and instructions for the Fiscal Year 1998 Welfare-To-Work Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been determined eligible for Indian and Native American (INA) Welfare-To-Work funding because it operates a Native Employment Works (NEW) Program; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is eligible for Fiscal Year 1998 funding in the amount of \$187,095.00; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has received information from the Arizona Department of Economic Security (ADES) that there are 639 enrolled tribal members receiving cash assistance under Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF); and

WHEREAS, the majority of these individuals are between the ages of 19-39 years of age, and 59% are long term welfare recipients who have received cash assistance for 12 months or more; and

WHEREAS, the services provided through the Welfare-To-Work program will provide support and funding to this target group with the goal of assisting in the transition from welfare to work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves the submittal of the Tohono O'odham Nation Welfare-To-Work plan for fiscal year 1998 by the JTPA/NEW Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the JTPA/NEW Program will submit finalized Welfare-To-Work plan along with a budget upon completion of committee review and approvals.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit; the Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any amendment affecting the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 9TH, day of JANUARY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
