RESOLUTION NO. 98-015

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Agreement has been extended through April 30, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the funding agency Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona has granted an extension of previous funding to the Tohono O'odham; and


WHEREAS, the extension is at no cost to the Tohono O'odham Nation for the Solid Waste Program under the Planning & Operations Department; and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Program under the Planning & Operations Department would like authorization from the Legislative Council to expend these funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the Memorandum of Agreement.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 9TH day of JANUARY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
