6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, in cooperation with the U.S.**
7 **Environmental Protection Agency will host the "*Conference of***
8 ***Native American Nations on NAFTA and Environmental Issues***
9 ***related to the US-Mexico Border*" in San Diego, California on**
10 **February 3 - 5, 1998; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been involved in border issues**
12 **affecting our Nation; and**

13 **WHEREAS, Councilman Kenneth Williams was selected to represent the**
14 **Tohono O'odham Nation at this conference.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
16 **Council hereby appoints Kenneth Williams to represent the**
17 **Tohono O'odham Nation at the Conference of Native American**
18 **Nations on NAFTA and Environmental Issues related to the US-**
19 **Mexico Border in San Diego, California on February 3-5, 1998.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the**
21 **9TH, day of JANUARY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a**
22 **vote of 1,738.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 189.0 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant**
23 **to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(b) of Article VI of the**
24 **Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
