9		proposed compact as selected by the court-appointed federal
10		mediator (former Arizona Supreme Court Chief Justice Frank X.

12	WHEREAS,	the Nation and the State agreed in the Compact that all disputes
13		under the Compact would be resolved by negotiation and
14		arbitration in accordance with the terms of Section 15 of the

16		Compact; and
17	WHEREAS,	all disputes with the State were resolved in that fashion prior to
18		1995; and
19	WHEREAS,	since 1995, the Arizona Department of Gaming, acting on behalf of
20		the State under the Compact, has refused the Nation's repeated
21		requests to submit disputes to arbitration; and
22	WHEREAS,	rather than submitting disputes to arbitration as required by the
23		Compact, in December 1996, the State of Arizona filed suit in the
24		United States District Court for the District of Arizona, Case No.
25		CIV 96-737-TUC-FRZ (the "lawsuit") seeking to permanently enjoin
26		the Nation from engaging in class III gaming activities as

7	alleged Compact violations asserted in the State's complaint arise						
8	out of Compact interpretation disputes which should be resolved						
9	by the parties through negotiation and arbitration in accordance						
10	with the provisions of the Compact; and						
11	WHEREAS, the Commerce Committee and the Nation's Chairman						
12	recommend that the Nation present to the State a proposed						
13	settlement to the lawsuit in the form attached hereto, and						
14	incorporated herein by this reference.
