

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving an Appropriation and Contract for State Lobbying Purposes)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 98-028**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the need to obtain legislative and administrative advocacy services in regard to programs and services of the government of the State of Arizona; and**

**WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Nation, in consultation with the Commerce Committee and the Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority, has identified potential candidates to meet the Nation's needs; and**

**WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Nation, in consultation with the Commerce Committee and the Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority, recommends that the Nation engage the services of a lobbyist to focus on issues within the State of Arizona pursuant to a contract substantially in the form attached hereto.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 1. The sum of \$50,000 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for purposes of funding a contract in Fiscal Year 1998 with a lobbyist selected in accordance with this Resolution pursuant to a budget of \$45,000 in fees plus \$5,000 in anticipated expenses.**
- 2. The Chairman of the Nation and the Commerce Committee shall agree on the selection of a lobbyist within 14 days of the effective date of this Resolution.**
- 3. The Chairman of the Nation is hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract substantially in the form attached hereto with the lobbyist selected in accordance with this Resolution.**

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

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4. For purposes of administration of the contract, the Chairman of the Nation shall be the primary contact with the lobbyist for purposes of directing the work of the lobbyist, and in the Chairman's absence, the Vice Chairman of the Nation shall be the primary contact with the lobbyist for purposes of directing the work of the lobbyist, and in the Vice Chairman's absence, the Chairman of the Legislative Council shall be the primary contact with the lobbyist for purposes of directing the work of the lobbyist, and in the Legislative Council Chairman's absence, the Chairwoman of the Commerce Committee shall be the primary contact with the lobbyist for purposes of directing the work of the lobbyist.
5. Any amendments to the contract affecting the funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Legislative Council.
6. Funds appropriated from the general fund for this contract shall be replenished from the IC-003 Account.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 23RD day of JANUARY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,276.0 FOR; 442.0 AGAINST; 95.0 NOT VOTING; and 114.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
