WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation requires the assurance of a 22.5% match by the Nation which amounts to \$5,500.00 at the time the van is awarded in 1999; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Executive Office, through the Department of Human Services and the Legislative Council will sign a letter of assurance to the Pima Association of Governments and the Arizona Department of Transportation that the Nation will match funds of 22.5% for the purchase of the van.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council does hereby agree to set aside the sum of \$5,500.00 from the Fiscal Year 1999 Executive Budget for Capital Expenditures for the required matching funds for a 14-passenger van for the Senior Services Elderly Program in 1999. If the grant application is not approved, the set aside amount will revert back to the general fund.
