

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1999 Appropriations Priority Listing)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-067

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council establishes priorities annually for consideration by Congress during its Appropriations Hearings; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Appropriations Committee recommends the establishment of top priorities based on the needs and type of services provided to the people; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Appropriations Committee has established four areas as the top priorities for FY 1999 for consideration by Congress during the Appropriations process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby adopts the following appropriations priority ranking for FY 1999 and respectfully urges Congress to appropriate such funds as necessary to increase the four areas to an exemplary level of funding.


