

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(In Support of the Tohono O'odham Education Department's FY 1999
Request for Budget Appropriations)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-069

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation covers an area in excess of 2.8 million acres and has a population of 23,000 people who are widely dispersed throughout the four, separated reservation lands; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is largely dependent on quality training and education of its membership, which is also dependent on appropriate funding; and

WHEREAS, economic development on the Nation hinges on the ability of the educational system to provide a pool of people with the expertise that will enable them to be contributors to their Nation's governance and economic future; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Education Department has submitted an appropriation request to expand services provided under the existing programs of Higher Education, Employment Assistance, Johnson O'Malley and the Tohono O'odham Career Center in the amount of \$1,342,802.52.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it recognizes and supports the request for budget appropriations in the amount of \$1,342,802.52.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 23RD, day of FEBRUARY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
