13		inadequate to meet the high demand of patients and clients suffering
14		from these conditions and the continuing rise in the number of

16	WHEREAS,	Indian Health Services (IHS) has been directed to implement FTE
17		ceiling and administrative budget cuts which further impacts on
18		already inadequate staffing and resources to fully meet the demand

20		and rise in the incidence of the Nation's illness and disease; and
21	WHEREAS,	it is the desire of the Nation to address the many health needs of its
