3	WHEREAS.	federal appropriations for road maintenance for the Tohono O'odham
4		Nation are currently set at \$451,755.00 and result in the attached
5		operating budget for the Branch of Roads of the Papago Agency which
6		
7		establishes that there are approximately 333 miles of paved roads and
8		550 miles of earth roads within the Nation served by a maintenance
9		crew of 4 persons and twelve pieces of equipment; and
10	WHEREAS,	because of funding constraints, the Branch of Roads is currently able
		to maintain only 287 miles of 550 miles of earth roads, and is unable
12		to effectively maintain the increasing number of paved roads which
13		are deteriorating almost as rapidly as new paving is added to existing
14 15		earth roads; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Natural Resources Committee of the Legislative Council has
17		determined that a crisis will result if existing roads are permitted to
18		deteriorate at current rates and has recommended that the Nation
19		seek additional appropriations for road maintenance; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Roads Maintenance Base budget has been raised to \$451,755 a
21		year, however, to adequately maintain all the roads on the system, a
22		yearly budget of approximately \$2,000,000 is required; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Council concurs in the Committee's determination and
24		recommendation.
25	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
26		that it does hereby urgently requests that Congress appropriate
27		\$2,050,500., as the base budget for the Tohono O'odham Nation's road
